The Bharatiya Janata Party seems to be worried about the angry leaders before the upcoming election. The top leadership is getting feedback that the angry leaders may damage the party's prospects after distribution of tickets.

This is the reason that the party leadership has decided to do damage control for the first time before distribution of tickets. Senior leaders of the party will be deployed to do damage control from now.

Leaders will be asked to check their supporters from contesting the election as rebel candidates.



For this reason, the party leaders plan to hold talks with the probable ticket aspirants.

Party's national general secretary Kailash Vijayvargiya will work in the Nimar and Malwa region.

Union Minister State Prahlad Patel and state Urban Development Minister Bhupendra Singh will take care of Bundelkhand.

Similarly, Union ministers Narendra Singh

Tomar and Jyotiraditya Scindia will work in the Gwalior-Chambal region.

The Vindhya region will be under the command of former legislator Rajendra Shukla and Member of Parliament Ganesh Singh.

On the other hand, MP Rakesh Singh and Union Minister of State Faggan Singh Kulaste will look after the Mahakaushal region.

Bhopal and its adjoining

areas will be under the charge of minister, Vishvas Sarang and former minister Rampal Singh.

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan and BJP's state president VD Sharma will also interact with the party leaders and convince them not to contest the election as rebel candidates.

The party is getting ready to deny tickets to many legislators because of anti-incumbency.

Against this backdrop, the party was planning to check rebellion after ticket distribution.

It is said that the BJP lost assembly election in Himachal Pradesh, because a large number of rebel candidates fought the election.

The same thing happened in Karnataka where a large number of leaders left the party after distribution of tickets.

This is the reason that the leadership is trying to deal with the internal squabbling in the party in Madhya Pradesh in advance.

33% police outposts on State highways deserted

The Madhya Pradesh police seem not to be caring at all about the commuters on state highways, as most of the police outposts remain deserted. The cops were either not deployed or were 'missing' in 16 police outposts out of 48.

Data of the number of road accidents that occurred on the state highways was sought from the Police headquarters (HQ), which revealed that a total of 13,680 road accidents took place in 2022. As a matter of fact, the majority of road mishaps took place on the spots where police outposts were devoid of cops.

In all 7,182 people lost their lives in road mishaps in the areas where such police outposts are located. Despite this, the police personnel are not being deployed at these outposts. Presence of the cops on the outposts could have averted many accidents and saved lives and also put a check on the incidents of loot and robberies on highways.

Senior PHQ officials accepted that some such highways are deprived of police personnel including State Highway (SH) 29D that connects Shahganj to Barkhedla, SH 38 connecting Nagda to Kasrawad, SH 45connecting Betul to Parasnia and many others.

Officials maintain that the presence of police personnel at the outposts located on the busy highways are of immense importance to keep a tab on over-speeding vehicles, issuing challans, checking hit-and-run cases and ensuring prompt and timely medical aid to

road accident victims.

Sources at the PHQ told Free Press that lately, the state police have been planning to set up 25 more outposts at various state highways, however, because of the space strain things are not moving forward in this direction. Most of the CCTV cameras installed in these outposts are non functional to have become obsolete thus failing their very purpose.

MORE POLICE FORCE SOUGHT FOR OUTPOSTS: ADG

Additional Director General (ADG) G Janardan said more police force has been sought to deploy them on the deserted outposts. Regarding the number of black spots on the highways, the ADG told Free Press that the data of the same shall be compiled later.

HEAD & NECK CANCERS ARE ON RISE IN INDIA: DR GUPTA

Ujjain: On World Head and Neck Cancer Day, city-based ENT and mouth cancer specialist Dr Rajeev Gupta detailed symptoms, treatment and prevention of head neck and oral cavity cancers. "In today's scenario incidence of head and neck cancers is rising fast. As per data about 40% of cases are of oral cavity cancers," he said.

Tobacco and tobacco related products such as Guthka, paan masala, bidi and cigarettes were the common cause of head and neck cancers, said Dr Gupta and added that youth were vulnerable in the disease, as using tobacco and cigarettes has become fashionable. The common symptoms of head and neck cancers were non-healing ulcers of mouth and tongue, swelling in throat and neck, changes in voice, difficulty in swallowing and difficulty in opening of mouth.

Dr Gupta said that people experiencing such symptoms should immediately contact a doctor. He advised that early diagnosis was important in treatment of head and neck cancer.

Man beaten to death in Neemuch, 6 held

In a shocking incident, 55-year-old Mannalal Ahirwal was brutally thrashed to death in Jannod village under Rampura police station of Neemuch district on Tuesday night.

A video of the incident also went viral, in which six people, including some women, were seen thrashing Ahirwal with sticks.

Rampura police station in-charge Anand Singh Azad said that those booked included Shyamlal, Mangallal, Jitendra alias Shyamlal Ahirwal, Bhawana, daughter of Shyamlal Ahirwal, Manabai, wife of Shyamlal Ahirwal, and Satyanarayan Mali.

They were booked under sections 302, 323, 506, and 294 of the IPC along with relevant sections of the SC/ST Atrocity Act, and all of them are arrested.

According to information, Balram Ahirwal of Jannod village was joking with his friends at a tailor's shop near his house. However, Satyanarayan Mali felt that Balram was making fun of him. This led to a dispute.

Govt plans to give more relief in power bills

The state government is coming up with a plan to give relief in power bills before the Assembly election. The energy department is working on it. Before the 2018 election, the government gave major relief to power consumers under Sambal Yojna.

The government may give relief by expanding the scope of this bill. Nevertheless, the Congress has already announced that farmers will be given free electricity for running five horsepower motors and their pending power bills will be waived off.

So, whatever the announcement the government will make on the power bills of farmers will be considered a copy of the Congress's proposal.

The party has already announced that if it comes to power, it will provide free power up to 100 units and make provision for half payment of bills up to 200 units. To counter the Congress's proposals, the government is getting ready to give relief to power consumers. The government is also mulling over giving 300 units for Rs 300 to woo middle class voters. The government is also planning to waive off old bills of farmers.

Congress to order inquiry into BJP govt's last 18-year expenditure: Nath

Former chief minister Kamal Nath has said that an inquiry will be conducted into the expenditures made by the BJP government in the last 18 years if Congress is voted to power in the state. The state has taken the loan of Rs 3.30 lakh crore and the Congress will look into the expenditure made by the BJP dispensation during the last 18 years, said the PCC chief while talking to media persons here on Wednesday.

Alleging rampant corruption during the BJP regime, the former CM claimed that foundation stones have been laid across the state only to get a 25 per cent cut from the project

amount. "Corruption in MP has become a part of the system which has deterred the new investors coming to the state. Investments cannot be demanded, it is to be attracted," he said. Speaking on the multiple visits of Union home minister Amit Shah to Madhya Pradesh for the BJP's election preparations, Nath said that "This shows the party's nervousness. They are seeing the writing on the walls."

Party launches Narmada Sewa Sena

Congress on Wednesday launched the non-political organisation 'Narmada Sewa Sena' to conserve the holy river. Making the announcement, Nath said a non-political 'Narmada Sewa Sena' is being formed in 28 places where the river flows, to save and protect the water body. Bhupendra Gupta has been appointed its president and Adipurush-fame actor Hanuman Vikram Mastal Sharma is the coordinator.

CM'S CHOPPER SENT TO MUMBAI BY ROAD

Nagda: Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan's helicopter that developed technical snag during his visit to Nagda on July 20 was on Wednesday sent to Mumbai by road. The helicopter had remained parked at the airstrip in Nagda for the last six days. Two days back, administration sent a technical team to the spot.



According to reports, lightning caused technical fault in the helicopter following which the CM had to return to Bhopal by road.
